





Therefore:







Principles of mentalism


- * Create surprise & confusion
- * Practice "cold reading"
- * Subtly make suggestions ("hypnosis"; anchoring)
- * Exploit confirmation bias / "incestuous amplification" / inattentional blindness







- Generate uncertainty, confusion, disorder, panic, chaos ... to shatter cohesion, produce paralysis and bring about collapse.
- Become an extraordinary commander.
